Subject: The new assessment in primary schools

Dear parents,

this communication, concerning the assessment document you will receive this year, is intended as a first pass of information on how the assessment of our pupils in primary school is changing.

Since the current school year, in fact, in application of Law no. 41 of 6 June 2020, the intermediate and final assessment of pupils' learning in primary schools is expressed by a descriptive judgement in the assessment document and referred to the different levels of learning.

Descriptive judgements, for each of the study disciplines, are drawn up and summarised on the basis of **four** levels of learning:

- In the process of being acquired for the first time
- Base
- **Intermediate**
- Advanced

These descriptive judgements are developed in the formative perspective of 'Assessment for Learning' and the enhancement of learning improvement.

So, while you are waiting to see your child's assessment document online, we wanted to give you a few pointers

information.

The new evaluation document will indicate:

- all disciplines;
- the objectives for each discipline;
- the level reached by the student in the individual discipline (according to the four learning levels listed above);
- evaluation of behaviour;
- the Interim Evaluation.

This new document makes it possible to better identify the academic progress of each pupil and the level of learning achieved, without using an arithmetic average of grades.
